(a) it demonstrates important aspects of the evolution or pattern of the State's history	<p>Shed 26 has significance because of its role in the maritime and industrial history of South Australia from the early years until 1988.</p> <p>As a construction of the 1950s it reflects the industrial modernization which contributed to the on-going success of our state of South Australia.</p> <p>It reflects the true character of Port Adelaide's involvement in repair and maintenance and maritime industrial activities. Shed 26 and the former dockyards are important to our ongoing sense of connectivity to the Port and its waterfront history.</p> <p>It gives as indication of what was here and the contribution of ordinary working people to the Port and to South Australia. Its preservation will retain that sense of significant historical importance for future generations.</p>

<p>(f) it has strong cultural or spiritual associations for the community or a group within it</p>	<p>Shed 26, is one of the few remaining remnants of the shipping-related repair and maintenance activities that were features of Port Adelaide's Inner Harbour, and of the work carried out there.</p> <p>Shed 26 is a reminder of the older history of Port Adelaide that is essential to the atmosphere of the Port. Once gone, it can never be replaced. It is a significant structure which if demolished will result in a degraded heritage and landscape.</p> <p>The industrial flavor of Port Adelaide can be promoted through the retention of Shed 26. It and other such structures provide connections to the past and to previous generations. They are vital for our on-going sense of community and belonging. It is a building of historical importance that can add to the life and atmosphere of new developments, which would be otherwise stark and soulless.</p>
<p>(g) it has a special association with the life or work of a person or organisation or an event of historical importance</p>	<p>The repairs for the whole of the South Australia's harbors and rivers plant occurred at Glanville - trucks for wharves and jetties along the coast, tugboats, motor launches, dredgers, barges, and craft of smaller dimensions all received attention at these works.</p>
